**Estimate of Obstetrical Charges for Patients with Commercial Insurance or not prepaying charges PRIOR to delivery**

\$1,380.00	6-8 weeks	1st OB visit estimate (Office Visit, Pregnancy Test, Prenatal Profile, HIV Screen, UA C&S, Gonorrhea/Chlamydia/Trichomonas panel, Pap Smear/HPV and Ultrasound if needed).
\$665.00	12-14 weeks	NT Ultrasound \$325.00 and U/S less than 14 weeks \$340.00
\$60.00	16 weeks	AFP (alpha-fetoprotein) blood test
\$400.00	20-23 weeks	Ultrasound

Additional ultrasounds may be performed for medical necessity which range from \$200.00 to \$325.00 depending on the procedure required.

Above are the standard lab tests our physicians follow based on ACOG guidelines. Additional lab tests may be ordered for medical necessity.

Circumcision cost (for a baby boy) is \$400.00 and is optional.

This is only an **ESTIMATE** of what the cost of your OB care will be with our office, and is considered for a "routine" pregnancy. All office visits (usually 10-14 visits), urinalysis, hemoglobins and one post-partum visit at 6-8 weeks after your delivery is included in the Global OB Care charge.

The above charges are our general tests done throughout the pregnancy for a single gestational pregnancy (multiple gestational pregnancies will require additional tests and ultrasounds). **There may be additional lab work, ultrasounds or nonstress tests during the pregnancy which would be in addition to the charges above.** Hospitalization during the antepartum care of the pregnancy is also additional.

**\*Note: You will want to check with your insurance company to see what tests are covered under your policy. Labs and ultrasounds may fall under laboratory or radiology benefits rather than OB benefits. \*\*\*\*\*Not all insurance companies cover two ultrasounds.\*\*\*\*\***

1. Associates in Womens Health, LLC
  2. Hospital bill (Methodist Women's Hospital or CHI Health-Lakeside)
  3. Anesthesiologist
  4. Pediatrician
